Biography

Tayf Masri is a multidisciplinary visual artist from Baalbek, Lebanon. His artistic practice emerges from the city's landscape, memory, and material textures, with Baalbek forming a central axis of his work, serving simultaneously as subject matter and point of departure. Drawing on his personal history as well as collective heritage, he works with collage, printmaking, and wood-based assemblages to explore notions of place, fragmentation, and identity.

Tayf Masri completed an artist residency at MACAM Museum (Museum of Modern and Contemporary Art) in 2024. He participated with his works in the exhibition In Memory of Aref El Rayess at the American University of Beirut in 2025, alongside artists addressing issues of heritage and memory within the context of contemporary Lebanese art. He also took part in a group exhibition in 2025 featuring contemporary artists who presented works engaging with contemporary social issues through printmaking and engraving techniques.

Habitus

The Habitus exhibition presents a contemporary reading of the relationship between local communities and the archaeological sites that surround them, considering these sites as living spaces that reflect current social and economic realities, rather than merely remnants of the past. This relationship often manifests through practices of neglect or vandalism, revealing an unspoken distance between people and their heritage, as well as underlying tensions related to identity and belonging.

The project is grounded in the concept of habitus to understand these practices as outcomes of the social environment, rather than as isolated individual acts.

Graffiti, neglect, or encroachment are read here as indicators of a complex relationship between people and place, and between the present and inherited legacy.

Within this context, the fragility of material archaeological remains reflects the fragility of the surrounding social and economic structures. The erosion of stone is no longer merely an effect of time, but a mirror of a deeper fracture in humanity's relationship with its history and environment. Thus, archaeological sites are presented not only as protected symbols, but as entities affected by their surroundings, carrying new layers of meaning through use, neglect, or rejection.

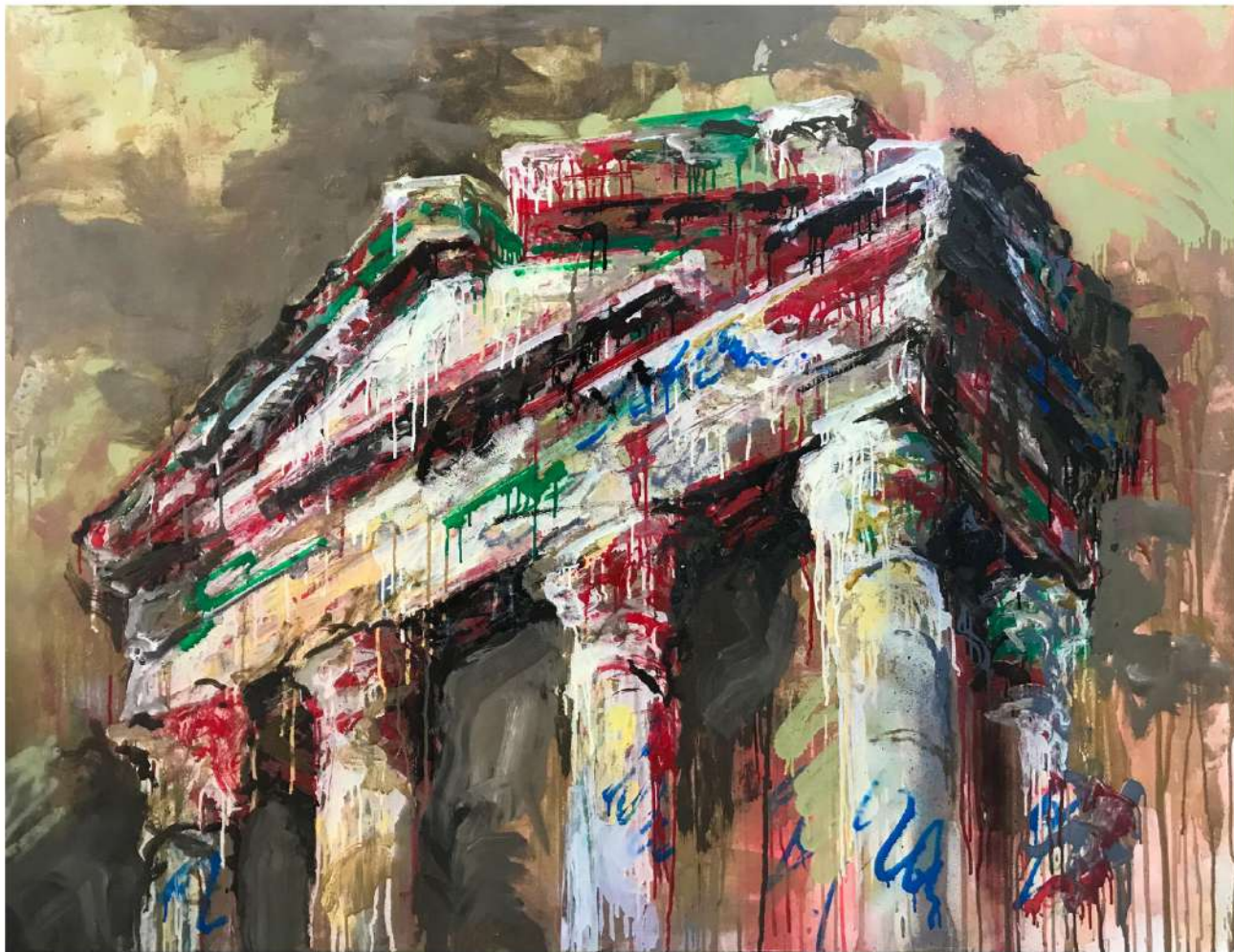
